Provide and promote rigorous exercise and physical fitness activities for participants and families. The world of tennis/fitness helps children stay physically fit, develop discipline, learn how to compete, develop social skills, earn college scholarships, travel Locally, Nationally and internationally, learn how to win graciously and how to lose with honor.

Expose participants to the lifetime sport of tennis in a success-oriented and friendly environment. Make the "game of tennis" accessible to participants through giving them the opportunity to belong to Tennis club, participant in Tennis Play Days, play on a USTA Junior Team Tennis Team, Junior Tennis Tournaments and eventually on their high school tennis teams.
